#### **Application information**

1. Short video presentation (Preferred option – limited to 3 minutes)
2. Written submission (Standard option – limited to 800 words)

The following can be used to help tell the story of how the nominated direct support professional represents the best in the Developmental Services field:

- *Describe a situation in which the direct support professional demonstrated excellence in one or more DS core competency areas.*
- *Share a story of the life of a person supported and how the direct support professional used her/his competencies to achieve successful outcomes.*
- *How has the direct support professional helped build a more inclusive community?*
- *What has the direct support professional done to demonstrate commitment to life-long learning and continuous leadership development?*
